LIGHT, ELEGANT & FRESH

Perfect aperitif or with fish, shellfish, white meat and salad dishes

- 1 Sauvignon Blanc, Paso del Sol, Central Valley, Chile, 2009** £3.70 £5.20 £14.95
Powerful aromatic nose with dry ripe gooseberry and grapefruit flavours.
- 2 Semillon-Sauvignon, You Me and the Gatepost, Frankland River, Western Australia, 2009** £18.95
A delightful blend of mostly Semillon from the cooler west. This produces a wine which is unusually fresh, breezy and zesty.
- 3 Pouilly Fumé, Les Moulin À Vent, Loire, France, 2009** £24.95
This classic Sauvignon Blanc acquires the term 'fumé' from the distinctive gunflint aromas of the wine, on the palate crisp and fresh fruit flavours gooseberry and grapefruit.
- 4 Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2009** £39.95
Superb, ripe peach, passion fruit, mango and juicy citrus, sprinkled with fresh fennel and a dash of Pastis. The palate is rich and succulent, with a zesty citrus and apple-sherbet acidity that leads to a long, lingering, and characteristically crisp finish

- 5 Chenin Blanc, Keates Drift, South Africa, 2009** £3.65 £5.15 £14.95
Pale straw-yellow with green hints. Delicate and elegant with light notes melon fruit.
- 6 Pinot Grigio, Delle Venezie, Villa Borghetti, Italy, 2009** £4.20 £5.90 £17.25
Delightful wine from Veneto. Dry and refreshing with a hint of almond on the finish.
- 7 Chardonnay, Unoaked, Crystal Brook, McLaren Vale, Australia, 2009** £4.05 £5.75 £16.75
Melon and pineapple characters on the nose and a ripe creaminess on the palate
- 8 Chablis, Domaine Christophe, Burgundy, France, 2008** £29.95
This world-famous white wine from Burgundy exudes class and style. Elegant with subtle lemony fruit, and flinty, mineral flavours. Highly rated by Clive Coates Master of Wine.

Melon and pineapple characters on the nose and a ripe creaminess on the palate
- 8 Chablis, Domaine Christophe, Burgundy, France, 2008** £29.95
This world-famous white wine from Burgundy exudes class and style. Elegant with subtle lemony fruit, and flinty, mineral flavours. Highly rated by Clive Coates Master of Wine.

RIOTOUS REDS

EASY, VIBRANT, FRUIT DRIVEN

Pairs well with red meats as well as tomato based pasta dishes and cheeses

- 9 Merlot, Paso del Sol, Central Valley, Chile, 2008** £3.70 £5.20 £14.95
Dark cherry red with aromas of red berries and eucalyptus. Lightly oaked with a soft, easy drinking with an elegant finish.
- 10 Montepulciano, D'Abruzzo, Villa Borghetti, Italy, 2009** £15.95
Intense bouquet of violets with ripe intense berry fruit with a sweet fig and on palate.
- 11 Cabernet Carmenera, Terramater Vineyard Reserve, Maipo Valley, Unfiltered, Chile, 2008** £18.00
Deep purple/red colour. Characteristic varietal, plump and ripe with attractive dusky dark fruit and notes of chocolate on the rich velvety finish. The winemaker insists on not filtering this wine as wants fullness of flavour - so may throw some sediment.
- 12 Rioja, El Coto, Crianza, Spain, 2006** £4.80 £6.80 £19.95
Raspberry fruits and soft spicy flavours, creamy with lovely vanilla notes after oak aging for nine months. International Wines and Spirit Challenge Winner 2010. Especially good with Lamb dishes.
- 13 Fleurie, Les Vieux Granits, Château du Chatelard, Beaujolais, France, 2009** £28.95
A rich cherry-coloured wine with violet tints and a delightful floral aroma, this has a smooth, deep, subtle hint of raspberries on the palate and a silky finish.
- 14 Pinot Noir, Mission, Central Otago, New Zealand, 2007** £29.95
This wine is full flavoured cassis with a fantastic silky roundness in the mid palate and fine grained tannins. A long finish of earthy notes. This is a top quality estate- the oldest winery in New Zealand. International Wine Challenge Silver Medal Winner 2010.

HEARTY, RICH & FULL BODIED

Excellent with red meats, game and cheeses

- 15 Cabernet Cinsault, Keates Drift, Paarl South Africa, 2008** £3.65 £5.15 £14.95
Rounded, soft and pleasingly fruity and excellent robust red that compliments red meats and cheeses.
- 16 Shiraz Crystal Brook Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Australia, 2009** £4.05 £5.75 £16.75
Full of black fruit and chocolate flavours with a spicy peppery finish. Pairs perfectly with red meats including steaks.
- 17 Shiraz, You Me and the Gatepost, Great Southern, Western Australia, 2008** £18.95
Very well balanced, minty red with plenty of juicy fruit.
- 18 Malbec, Alta Vista Premium, Mendoza, Argentina, 2007** £19.95
Big powerful dark wine with spicy aromas of ripe red fruit and liquorice on the palate. International Wine Challenge Commended 2010.
- 19 Gigondas, Domaine Raspail-Ay, Rhone Valley, France, 2007** £39.95
5 star tasting winner in Decanter Magazine 2009. A superb wine, harmonious and ripe fruit with earthy nuances.
- 20 Saint-Émilion, Grand Cru, Château Monlot, Bordeaux, France, 2006** £39.95
Made predominantly from the Merlot grape. Rich, full, silky and long. A lovely wine with superb balance and elegance, from great origins.

DELICATELY BLUSHED

- 21 Rioja, El Coto Rosado, Spain, 2009** £4.20 £5.95 £17.45
Garnacha and Tempranillo grapes, this modern-style rosé has a wonderful intensity of strawberry fruit aromas.
- 22 Malbec Rose, Alta Vista Classic, Mendoza, Argentina, 2009** £4.00 £5.70 £16.50
Excellent, big intensely coloured wine with ripe red fruit on the palate.
- 23 Pinot Grigio, Rosé, Villa Borghetti, Italy, 2009** £4.55 £6.50 £18.95
A pleasant, balanced, harmonious and fruity wine of good structure with floral notes and hints of pear and apricot.

FIZZ

- 24 Prosecco, Brut Spumante, Donna Trevigiana, Italy, Non Vintage** £3.95 £19.95
Dry, light, easy-drinking bubbly from north-east, primarily produced in the district of Valdobbiadene, in the region of Veneto. With mineral and earthy notes, along with tangy apple and peach scents. Made from the Prosecco grape. Ideal easy drinking bubbles.
- 25 Mercier, Brut, Non Vintage Champagne** £39.95
This is a wonderful rich, smooth Champagne from a great Champagne house. The richness comes from the available old reserves used in the blending.
- 26 Rose Champagne, Louis Barthelemy, Rubis, Brut, Non Vintage Champagne** £42.50
A wonderful family owned house in Epernay. Rated by Tom Stevenson, wine Guru, as in the 'top ten of up and coming producers'. This delicate pink is rounded with a fine mousse.
- 27 Mœt & Chandon, Brut Impérial, Non Vintage Champagne** £42.50
Classic Champagne nose and racy, well balanced wine of great character.
- 28 Veuve Clicquot, Yellow Label, Brut, Non Vintage Champagne** £46.50
A rich yeasty nose and plenty of fruit on the palate giving great depth. With a high proportion of Pinot Noir grapes, this is a full-bodied and intense Champagne with wonderful length.
- 29 Dom Pérignon, Brut Vintage Champagne, 2000** £120.00
This is truly an opulent fine example of this world class Champagne.
- 30 Louis Roederer Cristal, Prestige Cuvee, Brut, Vintage 2000 (Limited Availability)** £200.00
The jewel of the House is Cristal, created in 1876 for Tsar Alexander II. This is champagne at its finest, as inspired today as it has always been. The embodiment of elegance and purity Cristal is made according to the strictest criteria, based on a drastic process of selection applying to the vintage, the cru, the village, the grapes and finally the wines. Only Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes from the House's 10 most celebrated crus are used in the production of this legendary cuvée.

STICKIES

- 31 Elysium, Black Muscat, Andrew Quady, California, 2008** £7.95
Provocatively rose-perfumed with deep layers of sweet flavours of cherry, rose-petals and Turkish Delight. Andrew Quady only makes sweet wines, and boy are they good. The Black Muscat is one of the very few wines that is perfect with chocolate. Lives up to it's name, Elysium, is Greek for heaven!
- 32 Buller Botrytis Semillon, Victoria, Australia, 2008** £8.65
Rich and sweet and so delicious. Apricots, marmalade and a touch of lemon. Made by the traditional Noble Rot method. Multiple award winner.

Anni's Own Cellar Selection

WONDERFUL WHITES

Both these wines are so beautifully aromatic for drinking at any time and pair especially well with spicy dishes

- 33 Torrontes, Alta Vista Classic, Salta, Argentina, 2009** £17.50
Torrontes has become the white wine grape of Argentina. Alta Vista is one of the largest family-owned wineries in Argentina. The D'Aulan Family's mission is to illustrate the different Argentine terroirs. Alta Vista also this vineyard in Cafayate in the northern Argentinean region of Salta where the Torrontes grape is grown with great success. Floral notes are intense on the nose with a rich palate showing a slight herbal tinge to the rich-textured fruit.
- 34 Sauvignon Blanc, Mission, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2008** £19.95
Superb wine with wonderful crisp freshness and zing. Aromas of freshly-mown-grass are followed by gooseberry fruit with hints of lychee.

EXCEPTIONAL REDS

The concentration of fruit on these wines are great to savour on their own or with red meats, game and cheeses

- 35 Atemporal Blend, Alta Vista, Argentina, 2007** £32.50
Again from the D'Aluan Family. Balanced and smooth with rich fruitcake flavours and a touch of orange zest and dark cocoa. A truly wonderful blend of Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Petit Verdot.
- 36 Reserva, Museum Real, Cigales, Spain, 2004** £32.95
Made from vines up to 100 years old and matured for two years in French oak, elegant and powerful. With immense concentration of fruit this is a truly outstanding wine from our El Coto, Rioja winemakers. International Wine Challenge Silver Medal Winner 2010.
