HEARTY, RICH & FULL BODIED

Excellent with red meats, game and cheeses

- Cabernet Sauvignon, Le Sanglier, Old Vines, Caves Foncalieu, France** £4.60 £5.95 £17.95  
This is a delicious wine with minty and slightly leafy rich fruit. From an area near the walled city of Carcassonne.
- Corbières, 'Les Crozes', Château Montauriol Rigaud, Languedoc Roussillon, France** £21.50  
Ripe, spicy fruit from a predominantly Syrah blend.
- Solander Shiraz, South East Australia** £5.00 £7.00 £20.75  
Soft and fruity with spicy dark berry fruit flavours.
- Quinta Dos Carvalhais 'Duque de Viseu' Tinto, Dão, Portugal** £5.50 £7.25 £21.95  
Soft tannins, red and black fruits, spice and mint hints.
- Conviviale Primitivo, IGT Salento, Puglia, Southern Italy** £22.50

- Chablis William Fevre, Chablis, France** £38.50

## Exceptional Reds

The concentration of fruit on these wines are great to savour on their own or with red meats, game and cheeses

- Beaujolais-Villages, Vieilles Vignes, Château du Châtelard, France** £24.95  
From 50- to 80-year-old vines. The nose is clean and fresh with lively red cherries and strawberry fruit. The palate is medium-bodied with supple, ripe tannin, plenty of red fruit and quite a lush finish that is a pure delight. This excellent Beaujolais is a fantastic find.
- Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso, Villa Borghetti, Italy** £31.95  
Fratelli Pasqua is a family owned winery begun in 1925. Father Carlo and daughter. A delightful wine with intense fruit on the nose followed by lovely red cherry flavours on the palate. Cecilia refers to this wine as 'Baby Amarone'. Rich and ripe. So, so smooth with extra depth from the dried grapes used.
- Légende Médoc, Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite), Bordeaux, France** £36.50  
Complex red fruits mingled with sweet spices and liquorice.
- Raidis Estate The Billy Cabernet Sauvignon, Coonawarra, South Australia** £38.00  
Rich notes of blackcurrant, dried herbs, black olives and liquorice, with fine tannins.
